COMMUNITYHEALTH IMPLEMENTATIONSTRATEGY

Introduction

Cumberland County Hospital is a Kentucky, nonprofit organization, located inBurkesville,Kentucky. A board of directors governs the Hospital and ensures that the strategic directionofthe hospital consistently meets the health care needs of the people which it serves.TheHospital strives to provide high quality outpatient and inpatient healthcare services tothe Cumberland Countycommunities.

This document provides a summaryofCumberland County Hospital's plantodevelop new and enhanceestablishedcommunity benefit programs andservicesfrom FY2017-19. This plan is focusedonaddressing the top communityhealthpriorities identified in thecommunityhealth needs assessment conductedbyCumberland County Hospital inFY2016.



Identifying HealthNeeds

Cumberland County Hospital identified community health needs by conducting acommunityhealth needs assessment during its fiscal year ending June 30, 2016. Primary data wasobtainedby conducting key informant interviews. Inaddition, secondary data was compiled from demographic and socioeconomic sources as wellasnational, state and local sources of information on disease prevalence, health indicators, and mortality.

Data was analyzed and reviewed to identify health issues of vulnerable populations andthecommunity as a whole. Health needs were prioritized utilizing a method that weighs: 1)the

sizeoftheproblem;2)theseriousnessoftheproblem;3)theimpactoftheissueonvulnerablepopulati ons; 4) how important the issue is to the community; and 5) whether or notthehospital has existing programs to respond to the identifiedneed. Subsequently, Cumberland County Hospital's leadership entered into a dialogue to discuss the results of the evaluation and select health priorities. As a result of the analysis, the following areas were identified as priority areas on which we will focus over the next three years.

Priority: Prevention and Management of ChronicDiseases

- 1. HeartDisease
 - a. Cumberland Co. Hospital provides and will continue to provide community education regarding heartdiseaseat the Community Health Fair in September. Literature and informationandpatient education is provided on heart health and heart disease processessuchas atrial fibrillation, arrhythmia, high cholesterol, high blood pressure, and warning signs of heart attack. Tools are also available to help monitorbloodpressure and cholesterol. Free blood pressure checks areoffered.
 - b. Disease process information is given to patients for different diseaseprocesses.
 - c. Radiospotsonlocalradiostationtotalkaboutheartdiseaseandheartdiseasedetecti on and prevention. (Talk Around TownSegment)
 - d. Cumberland County Hospital has a weekly cardiology clinic with Dr. Frank Schwender and also offers echocardiograms and cardia stress tests for patients locally. Services will continue to be added as they seem feasible.

2. Cancer

- a. Cumberland Co. Hospital offers booths with educational informationandliterature on a variety of different cancers. (Including breast, colon, andskincancer) at the annual health fair in September. Preventative information aswellas screening information is alsoprovided.

Priority: Access toCare

1. Uninsuredadults

- a. Eachpatientwhoisadmittedtoinpatient,outpatientorswingisinterviewedbydischa rge planner and referrals are initiated to community resourcesasindicated.
- b. The hospital offers a financial counselor that is available for any patient.Thefinancial counselor helps to determine if the patient is eligible for KHCP, and ifso she assists them in the completion of the application.
- c. Patients who do not have insurance coverage are also provided with resource numbers. (i.e., drug discount programs)
- d. The Cumberland County Hospital offers a discount to all patients who makea prompt payment or who set up an acceptable payment plan with thefinancialcounselor.
- e. Cumberland County Hospital has added a Kynect Advisor to the staff. This employee assists uninsured individuals and assists him/her in acquiring insurance. This helps allow those patients to seek the proper medical care/treatment and keeps the costs to those patients down.

2. Preventative Care forElderly

- a. Discharge planner assesses all admittedpatients.
 - i. Discusses fall prevention and fall prevalence and risk
 - ii. Polypharmacy
 - iii. Medicationmanagement
- b. Patient education information is given to patients that have an identifiedneed.
- c. Discharge planner makes follow-up phone calls to each discharged patienttoidentify any possible needs that might exist after the patient goes home.Sheassesses things such as medication regime compliance, compliance withfollowupappointmentsanyproblemsorsignsandsymptomsthatthepatientma ybeexperiencing.
- d. Home visits for the elderly or disabled patients that are not able to travel to the physician's office has been implemented and will continue.

3. Transportation

 a. Since Cumberland County is a very rural community and most specialtycaredoctors are located outside of our area; Cumberland County Hospitalhascontracted with several specialty care doctors that specialize in differentareasof health (cardiac, gynecology, pulmonary etc.) to offer a clinic space withinthe hospital for them to practice and schedule appointments. CumberlandCounty Hospital hopes that this will help in delivering this specialty care tothose individuals whom have no way to travel to outside areas.

- RTEC is also available in Cumberland County and the CumberlandCountyHospital will help to schedule any pick- ups for any patients that are atthehospital if needbe.
- c. Cumberland County Hospital has added some equipment to assist the weekly cardiology clinic and allowing for more tests to be performed on site. For example a new stress test machine.

4. Shortage of Primary CarePhysicians

 Cumberland County is a Medically Underserved Area and acutely aware of the physician shortage in this area. As a result of this the Cumberland County Hospital is actively researching the possibility of adding long term local physicians.

Priority: HealthyLiving

1. Adult obesity and physicalinactivity

- a. Cumberland County Hospital offers a booth at the annual health fairinSeptemberthatfocusesonNutritionandhealthydiet.Caloricintakeandneeds assessment is provided, along with free body fat analysisscreening.
- b. Radiospotonlocalradiostationdiscussing nutrition and physical inactivity with sugge stions and benefits from improvement in these areas.
- c. Discharge planner sits up dietary consultations when appropriate fordietrelatedissues.
- d. Cumberland County Hospital employs a registered dietician whoprovidesnutritional therapy to inpatients as well as outpatients with physicianreferrals.
- e. The Cumberland County Hospital has collaborated with the local gym in offering discounted monthly memberships to employees. By setting a precedent and encouraging employees to participate in gym activities it is hopeful that other members in the community will follow.

2. DrugAbuse

- a. Cumberland County Hospital and the two Rural Health Clinics participate in the KASPER program to ensure that all prescription drugs are being usedcorrectlyand that the patient is compliant with the prescription.
- b. Cumberland County Hospital also participates in the local schools RedRibbonWeek. Several employees from the hospital visit every classroom of theschoolsystem from Head Start all the way to the High School to address the issuesoflegal and illegal drugabuse.

3. Tobacco Use

a. Cumberland County Hospital declared itself a smoke-free facility in 2009.Thestaff of the hospital is committed to education concerning the healthproblemsthat smoking causes. Education begins at the registration process, continues with the admission process through nursing, and concludes with the discharge process with the discharge planner. The hospital will continue to seek waystoeducate the populace of the dangers of smoking.
